Required Clearances for Volunteers

Devoting your talents to the church is an important part of stewardship. The diocese requires all volunteers, 18 years of age and older, to have obtained all of the necessary clearances and trainings. In addition, all current volunteers must have their clearances and trainings up to date.

When you have made the decision to become more involved in the life of the parishes and are ready to begin the process of obtaining your clearances or updating those clearances that you already may have, all of the necessary information and links can be found on the Diocesan website at www.dioceseofgreensburg.org, under the heading YOUTH PROTECTION: PA CHILD SERVICES.

The Diocesan mandated clearances and trainings for volunteers include:

- 1. PA Criminal History Report (every 5 years)
- 2. PA Child Abuse History Certification (every 5 years)
- 3. A notarized Volunteer Affidavit of PA residency of 10 or more years or, FBI Fingerprints for PA Residency of less than 10 years. *Please make sure that your affidavit is notarized.* (every 5 years)
- 4. VIRTUS Training— (or Recertification Training for those who completed VIRTUS in 2015 or 2016) (every 5 years)
- 5. Diocesan Code of Pastoral Conduct (one time only)
- 6. PA Mandated Reporter Training (one time only)

For those who are updating their VIRTUS certification: the diocese is requiring that one of the two recertification training courses be completed. The VIRTUS recertification course will take only 30 minutes of your time. Choose either "Protecting God's Children Recertification Training" or "Keeping the Promise Alive". Please make sure to print off your certificate once it is completed and submit a copy to the parish.

Please note that if you have completed the state mandated clearances for an employer or another organization, the parishes need to be provided copies of these clearances. In addition, the VIRTUS training program is the only child protection program accepted by the Diocese; there is **no** substitute.

The Annunciation of the Lord

Sometimes spiritual writers are accused of putting Mary on a pedestal and thereby, discouraging ordinary humans from imitating her. Perhaps such an observation is misguided. God did put Mary on a pedestal and has put all human beings on a pedestal. We have scarcely begun to realize the magnificence of divine grace, the wonder of God's freely given love. The marvel of Mary—even in the midst of her very ordinary life—is God's shout to us to wake up to the marvelous creatures that we all are by divine design.



God's plan of salvation flows through this faithful young woman, from the small village of Nazareth. Mary's response to the angel who brings the news that she will conceive and bear a son is one of receptivity and great faith. Mary's yes is the yes that allows Jesus to be born into the world. God desires that we say yes to him as well — that he might come into the world through us, his unworthy servants.

The Solemnity of the Annunciation also coincides with the anniversary of the papal encycli-

cal Evangelium vitae, also known as The Gospel of Life. This document, written by Pope St. John Paul II, reaffirmed the Church's constant teaching on the value and inviolability of every human life. In The Gospel of Life, Pope St. John Paul II challenged us to assess our efforts in assisting pregnant moms in need and to improve our responses, where needed, especially at the local level. In short, to truly accompany each pregnant and parenting woman in need. He writes: "With great openness and courage, we need to question how widespread is the culture of life today among individual Christians, families, groups and communities in our Dioceses. With equal clarity and determination we must identify the steps we are called to take in order to serve life in all its truth." EV 95

Our churches are concerned and are putting our faith into action through Grandparents Raising Grandchildren, an ecumenical social outreach mission of St. Cecilia Parish, Whitney, Sacred Heart Parish, Youngstown, and Trinity Lutheran Church, Latrobe. 
