

'In His dolorous Passion, Jesus' face and whole body were so

disfigured by the blows and scourges that Our Savior was scarcely recognizable. "I am a worm and not a man" (Psalm 22:6). Thus the wounds Our Lord endured hid both his divinity and his humanity.

For this reason we veil the crosses in the final days of Lent—hiding our Savior under the sad purple cloth.


