

Weathering COVID-19



While the offertory remained strong, the Diocesan Lenten Appeal, at first, suffered. In addition to the pandemic, the uncertainty of the parishes in Jeannette was a concern. What worried many was the repair at Sacred Heart Church suddenly coming to a halt when the damage exceeded what was anticipated. The temporary closure seemed to turn into something long term, possibly permanent. This uncertainty had a negative effect on the DLA. Following the Bishop's assurance of his support for the churches in Jeannette and the reopening of Sacred Heart Church for liturgies, a DLA extension campaign was run, and all indications show that it is rebounding well.



I do want to call your attention to some exciting news, though. We recently hired a pastoral associate for faith formation and evangelization, Elisa Esasky. Elisa will be bringing faith formation back to the parishes, along with heading up our evangelization ministry, youth ministry, young adult ministry and adult education. These efforts will go a long way in planting the seeds of faith in the next generation of our parishes.

In the meantime, Benedictine Father Job Foote has begun a lectionary-based Scripture study on Tuesday evenings, allowing parishioners to become better acquainted with the Bible. He has been working to strengthen the parishes' prayer life by having the rosary prayed before all Masses, eucharistic adoration before weekday Masses, and regular eucharistic adoration, confession and Benediction on Fridays. The first step in evangelization is becoming a people of prayer.
