Among our many blessings, we were privileged in June to host the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, part of the three-year National Eucharistic Revival. Strong parish and extra-parochial organizations such as the Holy Name and Rosary Altar Societies and the Knights of Columbus do much to serve our parish and community, including regular meals through Mosaic. 
Let me also mention the fish fry and the many other activities held this year to celebrate Sacred Heart's centennial, such as the Valentine's Dance.
