Deacon Bill's Updates:



GOSPEL: We just celebrated the Ascension of the Lord on Thursday. Today we celebrate the Seventh Sunday of Easter as we continue in the joy of the Resurrection. We are preparing for Pentecost and the Holy Spirit next week including the Novena for the Holy Spirit in the bulletin. In the Gospel Jesus lifts His eyes to Heaven to speak directly to the Father. He then prays defining the relationship between God, Jesus and us. Note the verse, " I made known to them Your name and I will make it known, that the love with which You loved me may be in them and I in them." Jesus refers to us as the gift to Him from the Father. It is this Divine love flowing from the Father to Jesus that we can claim for peace and healing. It is the love that gives us unity. It is the love that will perfect us and one day for those who believe, move us to Heaven.

CLEARANCES: We recently held a Virtus training with over 50 people in attendance. Certificates are at the office.

On Saturday, June 21, we will be hosting a PA Mandated Reporter training at Mersinger Hall. This is a FREE, in-house, LIVE training session from 1 pm to 4 pm which will be similar to the recent Virtus training we had. Please make sure to contact Jeannie in the office to register, as we have a minimum attendee requirement. If you are unable to attend this training, you are still able to go online with the Diocese to do it yourself online. Please know that volunteers and employees only need to complete the Mandated Reporter Training once—no recertification is needed. If, however, you need the training or aren't sure if you have had the training, please call Jeannie at the office to confirm what you need—and, again, to register for the June 21st training!


