Deacon Bill's Updates:



GOSPEL: Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. We all know the sign of the Cross...in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. **But what does that mean to you?** It is the mystery of the Holy Trinity, one God, three persons. In this short Gospel, Jesus who is the Word, wisdom and truth incarnate tells the disciples about the Holy Spirit. He also shows us the Father who has given him everything. God is creator, the first of all, the Alpha and the Omega. Jesus is incarnate and lived as a man, fully human AND fully divine. The Holy Spirit is often described as the love that flows between the Father and the Son. It is our advocate, advisor and enables our gifts. Reflect on this great mystery this week. How do each of the three speak to you?

PRACTICING YOUR GIFTS: Last week I noted the gifts of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We discussed the gifts at Confirmation from Isaiah: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Peity, and Fear of the Lord. Remember also the charismatic gifts from Corinthians Chapter 12: Wisdom, Word of Knowledge, faith, healing, miracles (mighty deeds), prophecy, discernment of spirits, tongues and interpretations of tongues. As Father Job encouraged in



gifts of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We discussed the gifts at Confirmation from Isaiah: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Peity, and Fear of the Lord. Remember also the charismatic gifts from Corinthians Chapter 12: Wisdom, Word of Knowledge, faith, healing, miracles (mighty deeds), prophecy, discernment of spirits, tongues and interpretations of tongues. As Father Job encouraged in


his homily, forgiveness is a spiritual gift that we need to live. Remember, these gifts are for us to use to build the kingdom. ***Practice! Trust in the Holy Spirit.***

EUCCHARISTIC PROCESSION: To actively participate in Corpus Christi Sunday, next Sunday we will have a Eucharistic Procession after the 10:30 Mass at Sacred Heart. We will start Mass and then before the final benediction, we will proceed from Sacred Heart to Ascension for benediction. The route is less than a mile and all downhill. We encourage carpooling dropping off people at Sacred Heart before Mass and parking at Ascension. We will have shuttles available before and after Mass thanks to our very supportive funeral homes. It will be a great witness to our community and a shared experience for families with children to see the power of the Eucharist as we process through town.

FATHER'S DAY: Happy Father's to all the dads in our community! You are the example for your sons and a nurturing force on how your girls perceive men. We have St. Joseph the protector of Jesus and God the Father as examples. Active church involvement is a great way to ensure faith is passed to your children. For those of you who had a tough relationship with your father, ask Jesus how to heal the relationship.
