

Deacon Bill's Updates

GOSPEL: In the Gospel today Luke emphasizes the rich versus the poor. The rich man is described as wearing purple, a color that was difficult to make and therefore only worn by the rich. He dined sumptuously every day. Not just during feasts, but daily excess eating. Based on what we read in the Gospel, Lazarus is helpless and was willing to take food scraps from the rich man's table. We can assume he was lame and it is noted to be diseased with sores. We see no signs of compassion or empathy from the rich man during his earthly life. As we all will face, both he and Lazarus pass from this world. As me might say, the rich man got what he deserved with tormenting based on his selfish and excess living with no regard for others. Lazarus was carried by angels to the bosom of Abraham. Luke emphasizes the chasm that can not be passed. The rich man finally shows compassion asking for allowing a change of heart for his family. But he is offered none. He seeks comfort through Abraham but receives none. The Jews were to give alms and were taught to give with an open hand. The rich man had none of this charity. He would not even give scraps.

Today's reading continues the sharp contrast between following God vs. earthly desires...mammon last week and the excess living this week. It is a reminder to us that God is merciful but also just. In the prodigal son, the younger son realizes the errors in his ways and repents seeking mercy with great humility. We can be so thankful for what Jesus did on the cross to cross that chasm between man and God. Born that man no more will die. Reflect this week with gratitude for what blessings we have been given in our daily lives and our chance for eternal life.

Focus on Prayer

Prayer is the way we communicate and experience our relationship with the three persons of God. This space will be use to focus on different forms of prayer and our prayer lives. This week, I want to focus on a technique called *Lectio Divino*. We have our Sacred Scripture that is the work of God as inspired by the Holy Spirit. *Lectio Divino* is a way to integrate scripture into our prayer life. There are 4 steps: Read (*Lectio*), Meditate (*meditatio*), pray (*oratio*), Contemplate (*contemplatio*). To start, you read the scripture, focus on a word or phrase that stands out in your mind. Meditate on focus word or phrase and what it means to you in your life. Pray asking Jesus what he wants you to know from the word or phrase. Last, contemplate with a gaze toward Christ and receive. You may want to journal in the process. Do not pick a long passage. Maybe the Gospel or reading from daily Mass. Try it and see what Jesus reveals.
