

Deacon Bill's Updates

Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. For me, this scene is one of the most dramatic in the Bible. Jesus approaches John for baptism but John does not feel worthy. Then after the baptism, Jesus came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." **JUST WOW!** We see the three persons of the Trinity and hear the audible voice of God. We imagine God's voice sounds something like James Earl Jones. Of course, we don't know and can't conceive the sound. He clearly announced, this is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased. This is God incarnate, Emmanuel. The Holy Spirit has preceded His humanity and resided in Him until Pentecost.

But even before the baptism, John has been preparing us for the Christ. He had already been baptizing and building a following. His simple message, "Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" He is a wild man living on locust and honey and wearing camel hair clothing. We might call him an influencer today. Think of the contrast with the pharisees in the temple with their formal dress and stature. Isaiah prophesied:

"A voice of one crying out in the desert, 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.'"

John the Baptist has already started the conversion to the New Covenant. But John knows his role. "I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the holy Spirit and fire." Paraphrased, I am only the warmup act. Wait until you encounter Jesus.

Take a moment and contemplate the power of Jesus. Envision yourself at the river seeing this event. What does the scene look like? What do you hear? **How do you feel?** We are given power in our baptism as prophet, priest and king. **Repent and call upon the power of the Holy Spirit to guide and heal you.**

PRAYER Last week there were about 50 people for prayer after Masses. We still have our personal prayer, the prayer chain, and all the opportunities to pray in our ministry groups. In the bulletin last week we had a stuffer on some different options for prayer. Try one.



Please note that when a minister brings the Eucharist to the homebound the Eucharist must be in a pyx and a burse. The pyx is not to be put into a purse or pocket. If you do not have a burse, please visit His Divine Mercy Religious Gifts to purchase one.

Thank you for your ministry at Mass. Please remember your role as an Extraordinary Minister is to function when a Eucharist minister cannot fulfil the role. Only Bishops, Priests and Deacons are Eucharist Ministers. To this end, when the deacon is present or a priest is concelebrating, they will serve and we may need fewer Extraordinary Ministers. If a host is dropped, immediately consume it. If you have a chalice, please remember to place it on the corporal when you return from distributing precious blood.




