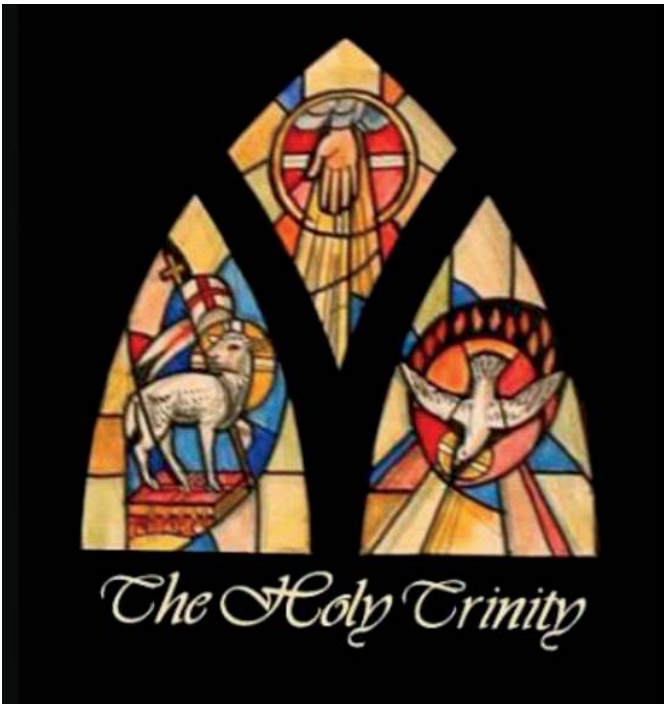

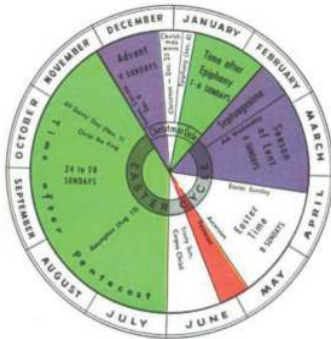


Deacon Bill's Updates

GOSPEL Today is Trinity Sunday. The Gospel includes the familiar John 3:16, “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life”. We remember the Trinity is three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Before discussing the Trinity, I want to take a step back and review the Liturgical year. We start with

Advent when we prepare for the birth of Christ. We have several months of “ordinal time” that marks the week. As we reach today, we have completed Lent as a time to purify and celebrated the resurrection of Jesus at Easter. We continue that celebration and with the Ascension where

THE LITURGICAL YEAR



Jesus ascended to the Father for his divine place in heaven. At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came down and empowered the disciples and each of us. Through these weeks, we see each person of the Trinity. God is creator, the beginning and the end, alpha and omega. Jesus gives us his forgiveness through reconciliation and in the Eucharist. The Holy Spirit guides us and provides “superpower” when we call upon the spirit to allow us to be more than our human selves. We can also pray to each person in the Trinity. This week, evaluate your relationship with three persons of the Trinity. Which ones do you feel close to? Are you longing for a relationship with another?

EUCCHARISTIC PROCESSION – NEXT SUNDAY we will once again have our procession between the parishes on June 7th after the 10:30, The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The procession will start at Sacred Heart and come through town with benediction in Ascension. The route is less than a mile downhill and less than 30 minutes.

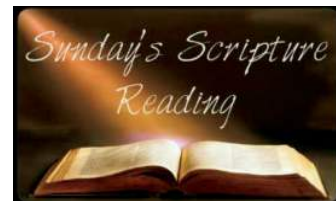

Stewardship Reflection

As your deacon and administrator, I am blessed to be able to serve this community. As disciples, we want to live the life of Christian Stewards. You have put into motion your skills with charity work at St. Vincent DePaul, building community and service through the Holy Name Society, the Rosary altar societies, and Knights of Columbus to name a few. We invest time with loyal faith formation catechists and many hours of service maintaining and beautifying our grounds. We are seeking eternal life and living a life worthy of the great gifts God has given us. "As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace". (1 Peter 4:10)

Looking forward, I believe we can not only maintain but grow our parishes. We are **real people experiencing the real presence of the Lord**. As Christians we want to share that good news. We can invite friends, family, and neighbors to Mass and other parish events. Just as Jesus focused on the lost sheep, we can welcome those in need of the real presence and offer prayer and healing.

In the beginning of May, I spoke about our income shortfall vs. the budget. Last week, we met with the Joint Finance Council representing each of the two parishes. With the council, we are evaluating our 2026-2027 budget (July 1- June 30). The preliminary view is expenses exceeding income by over \$45,000 in each parish. This year, we needed to use reserves to meet expenses and eliminate past debt. For next year, we have started to evaluate reducing expenses, but we need additional income through donations, new donors, fundraising and other efforts. These are wonderful parishes and through our work together and guidance from the Holy Spirit, I believe we can move to get into balance over the next several years. We cannot continue to rely on reserves and sustain the community. There are those of you who give faithfully and generously, and I am so humbled by your gifts and by those who tithe. For those who are not supporting our mission, please evaluate the value of your faith in your life. In Malachi Chapter 3 God calls us to tithe which is offering 10% of your income to the Lord's work. God has given us all gifts and continues to bless our lives. Please consider a 10% increase in your donations next year for those not tithing. Each of us has expenses, but God wants us to thrive by ordering our lives under His guidance. As we focus our thoughts and acts on God, we find our lives improving and our suffering manageable.

Please share your thoughts and ideas. Over the next several months, we will share more information as we work together to support our parishes. May God bless each of you.

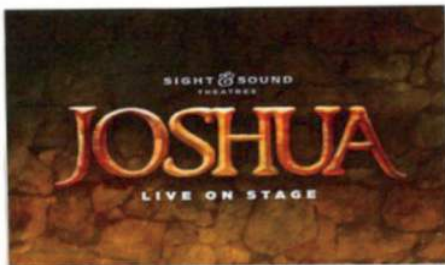
