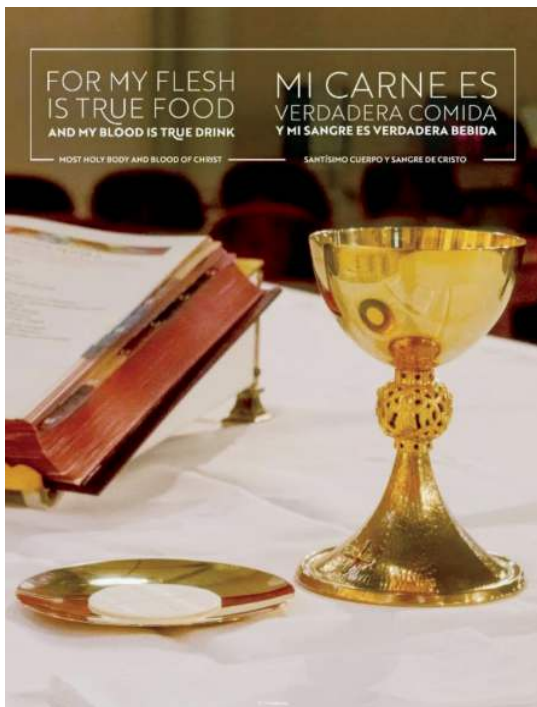

Deacon Bill's Updates

Our Gospel today is the heart of the sacraments and our faith. *"Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day.* When you hear, "**Amen, amen, I say to you,**" Jesus is saying, I AM VERY SERIOUS, LISTEN TO ME NOW. Some critics call the teaching cannibalism. It is not as Jesus is divine and not consuming his earthly body but his spiritual body. We hear a few verse later in John 6:66, many of the disciples left because they did not believe. Those who remain are true followers. Today, we receive the Eucharist that physically bonds us with Christ. Not just through prayer and devotion but a physical union where the divine Jesus joins with us. We are a combination of our physical bodies and our souls. We feed our body with physical food, but we feed our soul with the Eucharist, our spiritual food. As Paul reminds us, if we live in the flesh, we die with our physical body but if we live in the spirit, our souls are saved.

ST. ANTHONY– This week, on June 9th, we have the final St. Anthony devotion at 7 pm with dessert following the devotion. Please join us as we complete this powerful devotion. All are welcome...our community, family and friends. It is a powerful way to see Catholic devotion and ritual.

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART On June 12th, we will have a special Mass at 9 am and a reception to follow to celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The USCCB (US Catholic Council of Bishops) is consecrating the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as our nation celebrates 250 years. It is a special year and an honor for our parish namesake.

WHY ARE YOU CATHOLIC? As part of our evangelization outreach, I want to collect stories what your faith means to you. How did you come to the faith? Are there any special events, encounters with one of the Trinity or miracles that changed your life. I will never share your name without permission. 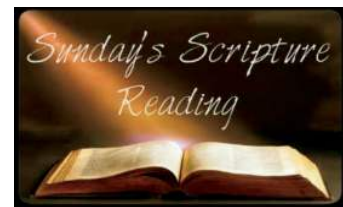

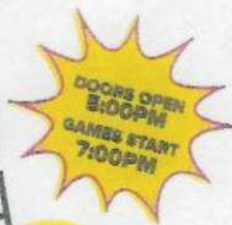
